

Christmas Granny Stripe bunting

(uk crochet terms)

This is a great way to make a little Christmas cheer from your odds and ends of yarn. I have used two strands of Yarndale Hope yarn held together.

3.5mm crochet hook

ch = chain / tr = treble st = stitch dc = double crochet

Ch 10

Row 1

Work 1dc in 2nd chain from hook. Continue working dc's into each chain till the end. You should have worked 9 sts in total. Turn .

Row 2

Ch 4 (counts as 1 tr, 1 ch), miss 3 ch, 3 tr into next ch, ch 1, 1 tr into last ch. Turn.

Row 3

Ch 3, 2 trs into 1st ch 1 space, ch1, 3 trs into last ch 1 space. Turn.

Row 4

Ch 4, (counts as 1tr, 1 ch), 3 trs into next ch 1 space, ch 1 , 1 tr into last st. Turn.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 seven more times. You can repeat these rows to make the chain longer if you wish.

Making up:

When you have made the first one make it into a chain by sewing or crocheting together the two short ends. You will now thread all the other ones you make into this chain and then sew together the two short ends as before, making the chain as long or as short as you like!
